



Yellowknives Dene First Nation High School Achievement Award Criteria Guidelines

Yellowknives Dene First Nation (YKDFN) High School Achievement Award Program is available to all YKDFN Beneficiaries for completing high school and receiving a diploma.

The program was established by YKDFN Chiefs and Council with financial contribution from Diavik Diamond Mines Inc. (DDMI) to support and encourage beneficiaries to complete their high school education and continue further onto post-secondary in pursuing academic excellence.

High School Achievement Awards are available in the following amounts:

- \$500.00 for receiving a high school diploma
- \$250.00 for receiving a certificate for leaving high school
(remaining \$250.00 can be released upon receiving a high school diploma).

Applications are available. We recommend applying 2-3 months after completing high school to allow official transcripts to be updated with your final year grades as requesting too early may lead to a false and non-graduated status. Be advised that incomplete applications and missing documentation will delay application process.

Eligibility Criteria and Application Requirements:

- Open to YKDFN Members;
 - Must provide proof by photocopy of Treaty Status Card,
- Must complete an YKDFN High School Achievement Award Application;
- Must provide official transcript verifying graduation status;
- Must provide copy of high school diploma/certificate.
