### **Community Members:**

**Please be reminded that all high school students must use the school bus transportation provided for them in the mornings and after school. All students from Dettah Grade 9 -12 are required to use the bus service provided to them.**

**No children K-8 will be permitted to use the shuttle van if attending school in Yellowknife. Parents must make their own transportation arrangements.**

**The purpose of the van shuttle is to transport community members back and forth from Dettah to Yellowknife who do not have transportation. Students will only be permitted on the bus in the morning and noon provided they are with a parent and travelling for appointments. We will not assist in skipping school.**

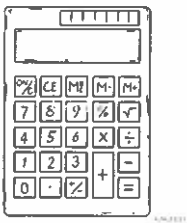
**It is not a school bus service. And students who have decided to miss the morning bus for any reason will not be given priority on the shuttle van at any time. They may be allowed to ride the van on the 4:30 pm shuttle if they have been attending after school events, but will not be given priority. If bus has more seniors and adults, students will be made to give up seating.**

**Also the shuttle van does not have to provide service to non-community members who do not live in the community if there is no room in the van. And a reminder that no intoxicated riders will not be allowed in the van.**

**Again, first priority riders are elders and adult community members.**

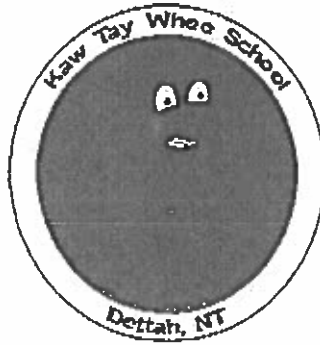

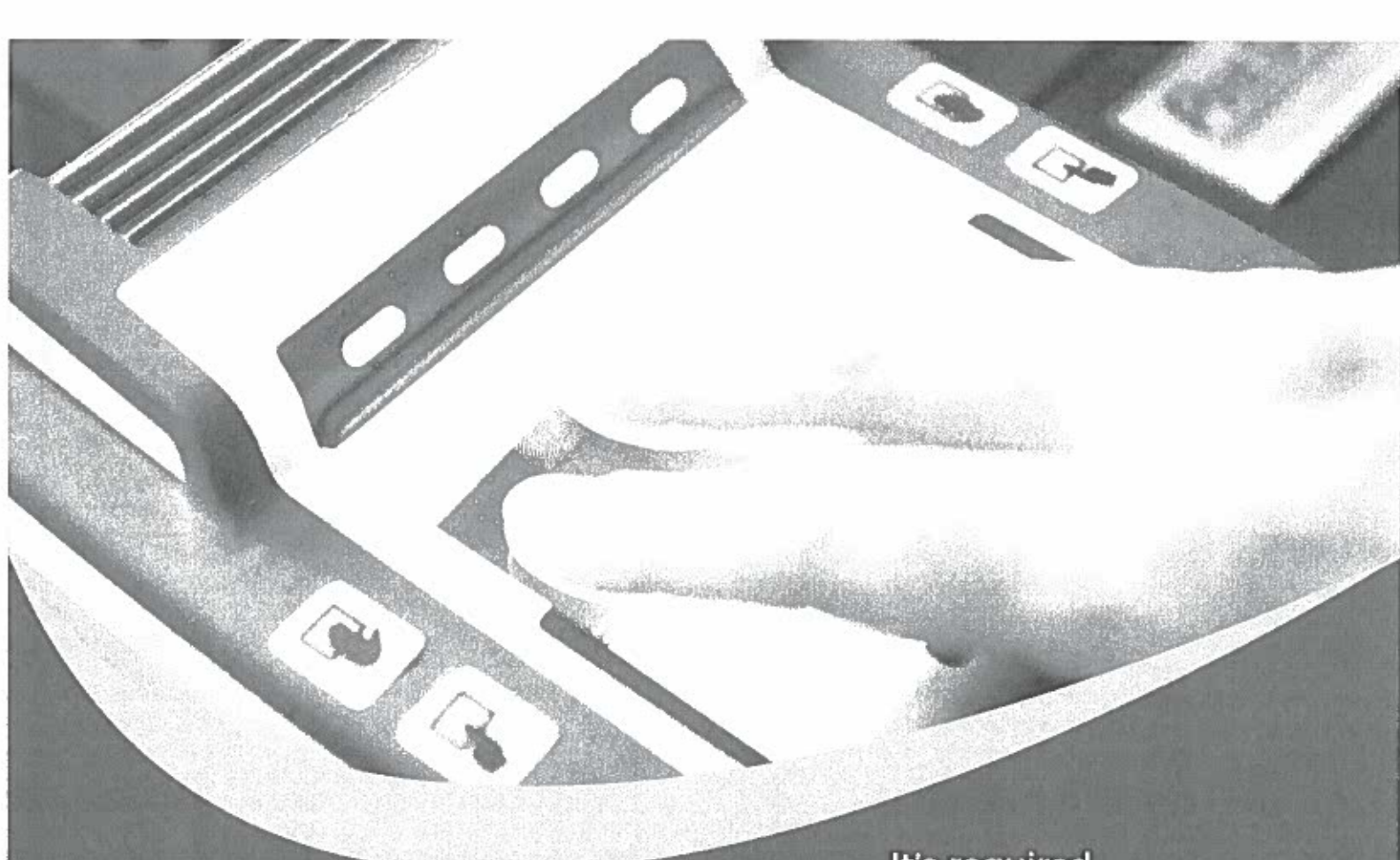

When you lose someone in death, go to the family right away, help out the widow as much as possible and help take care of the orphaned children.

## ***Love each other as much as possible***

Treat each other as brother and sisters as though you are related. Help each other and don't harm anyone.

## ***Be respectful of Elders and everything around you***

Don't run around when Elders are eating; sit down until they are finished.

## ***Sleep at night and work during the day***

Don't run around or laugh loudly when it gets dark. Everyone should sleep when darkness falls.

## ***Be polite and don't argue with anyone***

Don't harm anyone with your voice or actions. Don't hurt anyone with your power. Don't show your anger.

## ***Young girls and boys should behave respectfully***

Don't make fun of each other, especially in the matter of sex. Don't make fun of older men and women. BE polite to each other.

## ***Pass on the Teachings***

Elders are to tell stories about the past every day. In this way, young people learn to distinguish between good and unacceptable behaviours and when they are older, they will become the storytellers someday, who will then someday keep the circle of life going.
