The candidate must be able to work with minimal supervision and interact with the public housing tenants in a friendly yet professional manner.

The ideal candidate for this position will have a completed a trade related certificate such as carpentry, plumbing, electrical, oil burner or housing maintainer program and coupled with two (2) years' work experience; a valid Class '5' driver's license; and a First Aid/CPR and WHMIS certificates.
